We do not enter into business with any organisation, in the UK or abroad, which knowingly supports or is found to be involved in slavery, servitude and forced or compulsory labour.

Our supply chain

Due to the nature of our business, we assess ourselves to have a low risk of modern slavery in our business and supply chains.

Our supply chains are limited and we procure goods and services from a restricted range of UK and overseas suppliers.

Roberts Mart & Co Ltd are a member of SEDEX, who are one of the world's leading ethical trade membership organisations. We utilise the SEDEX online platform, tools and services to help ensure we operate responsibly, sustainably, protect our workers and source ethically.

The company undertakes due diligence when considering taking on new suppliers, and regularly reviews its existing suppliers.


Embedding the principles
