Environmental Policy

General Statement of Policy

The company is committed to fulfilling our environmental compliance obligations. The company recognises how business activities such as purchasing, planning, manufacturing, waste and travel can impact the environment as a plastics manufacturer.

Aims and objectives will be pursued as far as is reasonably practicable:

- To fulfil and ensure compliance with all current environmental legislation and permits, preventing/ reducing environmental pollution.
- Commitment to the continual improvement of the environmental management system to enhance our environmental performance.
- To optimise consumption of all raw materials used, including water, fuel and energy.
- To optimise waste production and disposal through the waste hierarchy and waste: duty of care
- To ensure any waste generated is labelled, stored and disposed of correctly.
- To keep to a minimum the number of solvents and other hazardous chemicals within the workplace/ atmosphere.
- To maintain the lowest noise levels practicable.
- To co-ordinate deliveries and sales calls to reduce transport costs and energy
- To develop systems for the responsible purchase, development, operation and maintenance of plant and associated processes to reflect the principles above.
- To ensure all Employees, Visitors & Contractors understand and comply with this policy.
- To continue increasing environmental awareness throughout our sites by means of training, meetings and noticeboards.
- To periodically review and revise this policy.

The Managing Director is accountable for endorsing this Policy, annual review and ensuring that our subsidiaries are aware of and committed to the policy expectations. Sufficient funds and resources shall be provided to enable effective environmental management in all business operations.
